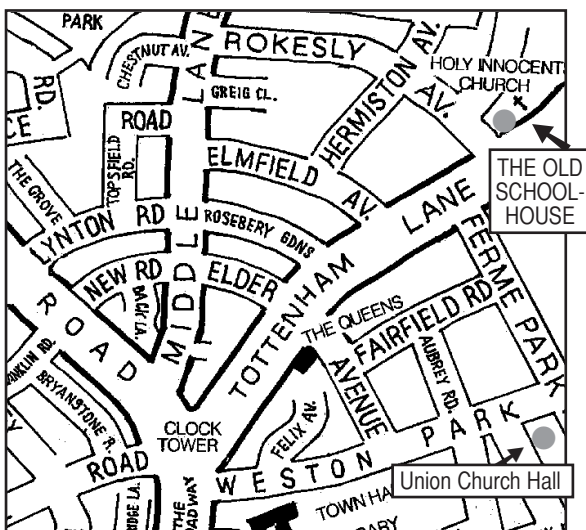

**TRANSPORT:** Buses W3, 41 and 91 stop near The Old Schoolhouse. Parking is available locally, except between 11.00 and 12.00 (check CPZ signs).
